Expectations

- Facilitators should be available to **arrive on July 18, 2010**. The facilitator training will begin the morning of July 19th and run until July 23rd. The facilitators then support the program for the 100 youth participants starting July 24th. The role will last until **departure on the morning of August 13th**. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate early arrivals or late departures.
- Facilitators will be responsible for covering their own travel costs, however accomodation, food, and training are all provided at no cost.
- Facilitators will be responsible for making their own travel arrangements, and for ensuring that they communicate their arrival information to Pearson College by June 1st, 2010.
- Facilitators should expect to be full-participants during the entirety of the seminar, and to be present and actively engaged in all activities.
- The PSYL program for the participants will run from July 24 – August 13, 2010.
